Hire of a Bouncy Castle in Ashurst Village Hall

Ashurst Village Hall require the assurance that any hire of Bouncy Castles used within the hall, are hired from a reputable company who carry their own insurance regarding injury incurred whilst using the Bouncy Castle. In addition, our own insurers require you to adhere to the following conditions.

- not allowing overcrowding, particularly by children (to help prevent knocking into each other)
- not allowing a mix of large and small children at the same time (to avoid larger children crushing the smaller ones)

not allowing use by adults and children at the same time If you use any bouncy castle and/or any other land-based inflatable, you must ensure that:

- access and use is controlled by an authorised adult employee/volunteer at all times
- when used outside a building, it is securely anchored to the ground at each anchor point
- each anchor point is signed, or otherwise marked to be made easily visible, and wrapped to prevent injury
- soft matting is used to cover hard surfaces adjacent to the front or any open sides where there is a risk of injury from falling from the inflatable

In addition, using bouncy castles can increase the risk of injury, particularly to children and others who may not be aware of the dangers. Where you provide, or are responsible for, bouncy castles we expect you to take extra care to prevent injuries by making sure measures are put in place that help reduce this risk and our guidelines are:

- to follow the manufacturers or supplier's safety recommendations
- requiring children to remove sharp articles like shoes, buckles or jewellery

- not allowing any access to the very youngest children, e.g. under 2 years old

We reserve the right to refuse Bouncy Castles that are not hired under the above conditions.
